INTRODUCTION

Coronavirus, or COVID-19, is a highly infectious contagious disease.

It has a long and silent incubation period (up to 14 days) where it can also be spread by the carrier while being asymptomatic.

The COVID-19 disease outbreak has been classified as a global pandemic. This has resulted in lockdowns and restrictions from national to a local level.

SYMPTOMS

For those that have experienced symptoms while suffering from this potentially lethal virus, the most common symptoms of COVID-19 are fever, dry or persistent cough, and tiredness. Other symptoms that are less common and may affect some patients include loss of taste or smell, aches and pains, headache, sore throat, nasal congestion, red eyes, diarrhoea, or a skin rash.
